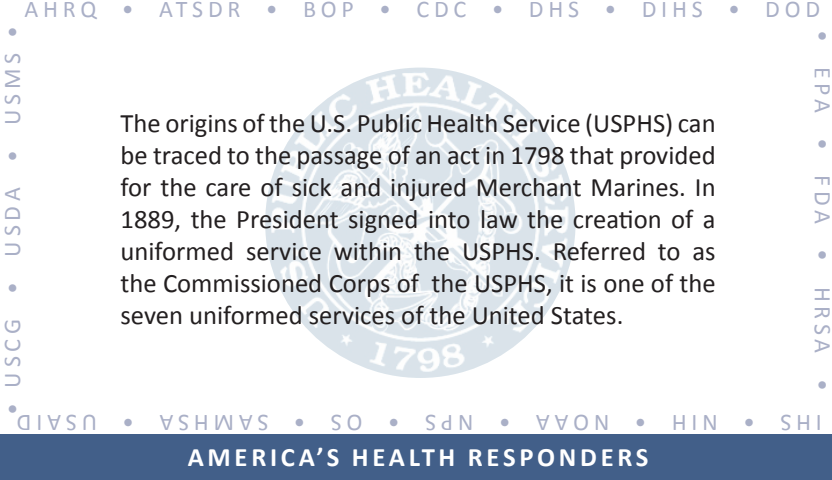




Environmental Health Officer



The origins of the U.S. Public Health Service (USPHS) can be traced to the passage of an act in 1798 that provided for the care of sick and injured Merchant Marines. In 1889, the President signed into law the creation of a uniformed service within the USPHS. Referred to as the Commissioned Corps of the USPHS, it is one of the seven uniformed services of the United States.
