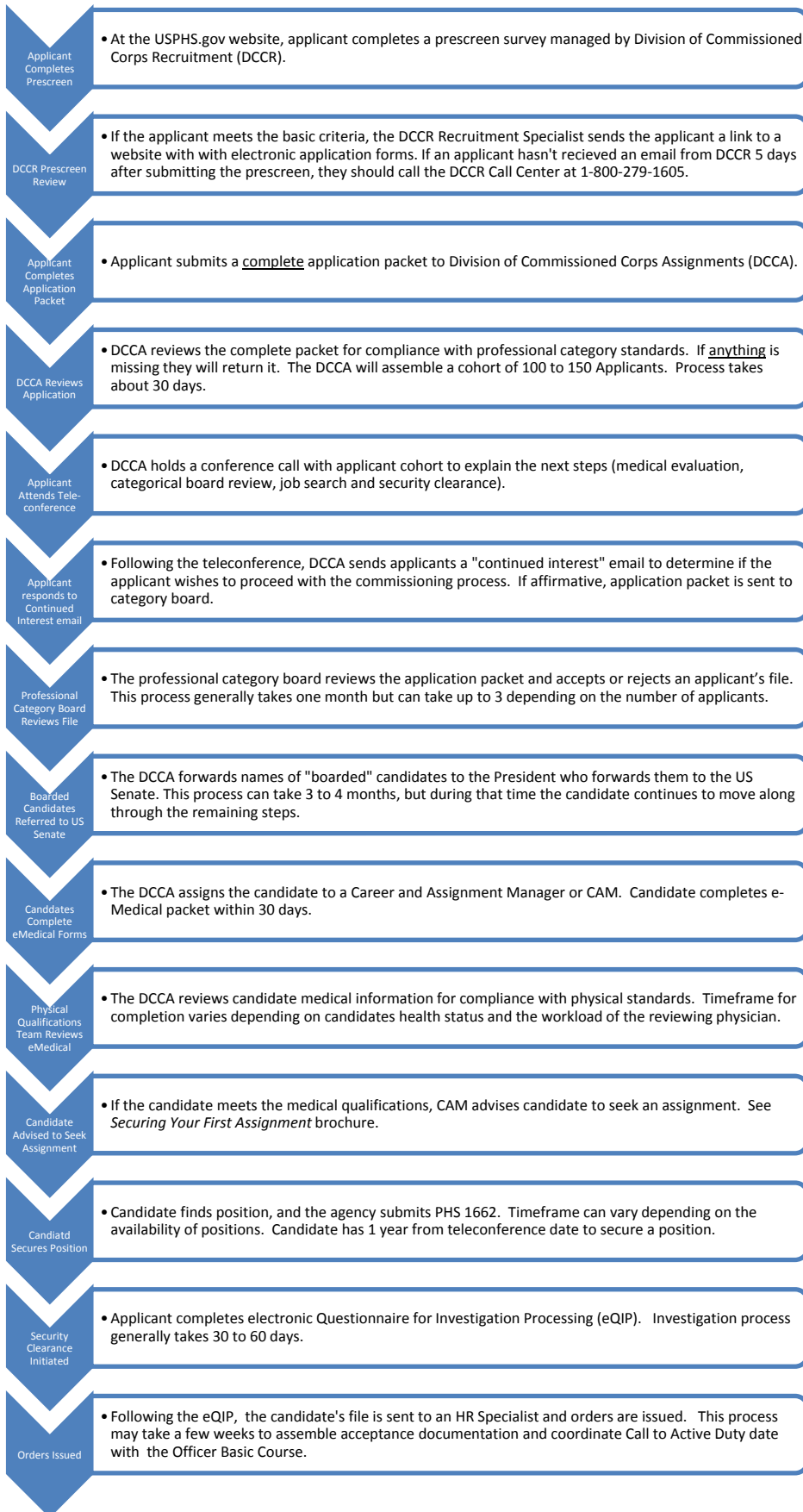


Lifecycle of an Application

From Pre-Screen to Call to Active Duty



How Long Does the Application Process Take? While it can take up to a year, most applicants complete the process in approximately six months.

Does an Application have a Shelf Life? Applicants have one year from the date of their DCCA cohort teleconference to find a position or the process starts over.

How Far in Advance Can a Student Apply? DCCA is encouraging students to apply two semesters before graduating. Students can be boarded, medically cleared, and have job offers prior to graduating, but DCCA needs to document final transcripts before call to active duty orders are issued.
